 "Brother Wolf, since you are willing to make and keep this peace pact, I promise you that I will have the people of this town give you food every day as long as you live, so that you will never again suffer from hunger, for I know that whatever evil you have been doing was done because of the urge of hunger.

But, my Brother Wolf, once I am obtaining such a favour for you, I want you to promise me that you will never harm any animal or person. Will you promise me that?" The wolf gave a clear sign, by nodding its head, that it promised to do what the Saint had asked.

 When the people saw this they were greatly amazed and the news spread quickly throughout the whole town, so that all of them, men as well as women, great and small, assembled on the market place, because St. Francis was there with the wolf.





6. Repenting: Doing 實踐

 "Listen, dear people," he said. "Brother Wolf, who is standing here before you, has promised me and has given me a pledge that he will make peace with you and will never hurt you if you promise also to feed him every day. And I pledge myself as bondsman for Brother Wolf that he will faithfully keep this peace pact."

 Then all the people who were assembled there promised in a loud voice to feed the wolf regularly. And St. Francis said: "Brother Wolf, I want you to give me a pledge here and before all these people that you will keep the pact and will never betray me for having pledged myself as your bondsman. Then in the presence of all the people the wolf raised its right paw and put it in St. Francis' hand as a pledge " 51/100

 And the crowd was so filled with amazement and joy over the novelty of the miracle and over the peace pact between the wolf and the people, that they all shouted to the sky, praising and blessing the Lord Jesus Christ.


